Description

Date 224/3-188/7 BCE

Period: 3rd century BCE --> second half --> after 229 BCE, liberation from Macedonian control

Reasons: archon, cutter's hand

Text category decree (religious matters)

Notes:

According to Lambert AIO Papers 4, 2014, 31, this inscription contained provisions for the kathairesis of a sanctuary, and not honorary decrees for sacred overseers, as assumed also recently in IG II3 edition.
